



Faith Ministry Training Institute Leadership Level Project

The Ministry Leadership Project is an individualized ministry project planned and implemented by the student after praying and receiving an idea for ministry from God. Each step is to be carried out in collaboration with a Faculty Advisor.

Procedure:

- 1.** Spend ample time in prayer to receive an idea for ministry from the Lord.
- 2.** Speak with a Faculty Advisor about your ministry idea to obtain clearance for your choice.
- 3.** Write the vision and create a plan for your project. The Ministry Project Forms from the Planning For Success class can be used and should be referenced during the plan building phase.
- 4.** Meet with your Faculty Advisor to discuss the plan.
- 5.** Make sure you've informed and cleared the project if necessary with your pastor.
- 6.** Carry out your project.
- 7.** Submit a written report including copies of your vision, plan, and any other important detailed logs of the process along with an overall project review. Your review should discuss your experience in leading a team, highlight your growth in the process, the results of your project, and critical evaluation of your effort.
- 8.** Make an appointment with you Faculty Advisor to discuss.
